Proposal for an Addendum to the Constitution of Brixham Community Partnership

It is proposed that the following Addendum be put to the BCP public meeting on Friday 5th October 2018:

Article 16.0 Dormancy

Notwithstanding Article 17.0 (Dissolution), it is felt that the Brixham Community Partnership is too important a non-political public forum to dissolve. The Brixham Community Partnership may be put into a state of dormancy with the agreement of a majority of those members of the public attending a public meeting of the BCP. Prior notice of this intention will be communicated to the membership of the BCP by email, and to the wider Brixham community through local publications so that as many residents as possible may attend the public meeting. Thereafter, a public Annual General Meeting will be held in April each year to confirm the dormancy. Should the need arise for a public meeting to be called, a request may be made by Brixham Town Council Town Clerk, or by a Brixham resident, to mobile number 07460 253442, or to email address bcpchair@gmail.com. Any such meeting called will be chaired by the BCP Honorary President, or their nominated representative.

In order to continue to function as a disseminator of information of interest to the BCP membership, to preserve BCP records and to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation Act (2018), the Secretary will retain the emailing lists and written records of the BCP, and the Treasurer will continue to operate the BCP account, these positions to be confirmed at each AGM.
