<p>3. Princes Foundation Workshops Those who had attended the workshops agreed that it had been a worthwhile exercise and outlined what had happened at the workshops. KB reported she had received the Princes Foundation slide presentations and these are to be sent to all members of the Forum on e mail. It was noted that the development sites identified more than met the suggested housing target. It was felt that the transport workshop was very positive with some good thoughts on potential park and ride sites. Better use of rail and sea travel. There was a clear recognition that jobs led housing demand. The Town centre group felt that their table had been dominated by a Councillor who only wanted Tesco and to get cars into Brixham, was in conflict with the others at the table.
